## **Assembly Instructions For The Marlboro Rocker**

Tools Needed:
Power Screwdriver
#2 Square Drive Bit

Parts List:
Seat Assembly (1)
Back Assembly (1)
Left Arm & Leg Assembly (1)
Right Arm & Leg Assembly (1)
Rockers (2)
Leg Brace (1)

Hardware: 1/4" x 3-1/2" Bolts (2) 1/4" x 2-3/4" Bolts (4) 1/4" x 2-1/2" Bolts (8)

3" Screws (4) Allen Wrench (1)

- Attach the arm & leg assemblies to the seat assembly. (The curved side of the arm & leg belongs on the outside). Insert a 2-3/4" bolt through the predrilled hole in the front leg & turn into the insert in the side of the seat assembly with the Allen wrench. The front leg has only 1 predrilled hole in the side of the leg & the back leg has 2 predrilled holes. (Do not fully tighten any bolts until the chair is fully assembled).
- Step 2 Place the back assembly between the back legs of the rockers. Align the top predrilled hole underneath the arm with the threaded insert in the side of the back assembly & insert a 3-1/2" bolt on each side.
- Attach the bottom of the back assembly to the seat assembly. Align the bottom of the 2x2s of the back with the bottom edge of the seat & fasten with four 3" screws in the predrilled holes. No predrilled holes are needed in the seat as screws are self-drilling.
- Step 4 Attach the back leg brace between the back legs. (If it does not fit between the legs loosen the bolts under the arms). Insert a 2-3/4" bolt in the holes in the side of the legs & turn into the threaded inserts in the leg brace.
- Now attach the rockers to the leg assemblies by aligning the holes in the rockers with the threaded inserts in the legs. Place the rockers on the outside of the legs, insert four 2-1/2" bolts through each rocker & turn into the inserts in the legs. Make sure you have the longer end of the rocker at the back of the chair. Now fully tighten all bolts with the Allen wrench.
